## De-registration is not the end!

Occasionally, registered Gas Practitioners disregard the Pressure Equipment Regulations (PER) putting the life of the end-user at risk. These regulations are not lenient to anyone, not adhering to the PER can be hazardous, and even result in death.

**When a de-registered Gas Practitioner wishes to jump on the legal boat again, there is a way!**

A Registered Gas Practitioner completed an installation in a complex where soon after complaints were received with regards to various serious problems pertaining to the installation. After a thorough hearing, he was de-registered.

The Gas Practitioner could have chosen to continue practicing illegally and remaining an illegal installer in the black market with no hope of closing big contracts.

However, he acknowledged his error and fixed it. He registered for a Refresher Course, which he has successfully completed. He is once again a compliant registered Gas Practitioner.

## Selling your CoC Book is prohibited!

Persons to whom CoC books have been issued must be made aware that any false declaration made in these books will make him or her liable to prosecution.

If these books or individual CoC's are misplaced, lost or stolen the matter needs to be immediately reported to the respective Gas Association. Failing to do so will be regarded as gross negligence on the part of the person to whom these books were issued and lead to disciplinary action by the appropriate gas association.

Should a registered Gas Practitioner leave the Gas Industry, he/she is not allowed to sell the CoC book that was allocated to them. If you are longer practicing in the Gas Industry, please submit the remaining CoC documents to the relevant associations to avoid fraudulent activities.
