Always ask for a COC!

A Certificate of Conformity (CoC) for Gas installations is a legal document which must be obtained from a registered Gas Practitioner whenever a gas system is installed, modified or repaired and should be retained for a minimum period of 12 years for record purposes.

In the case of a gas related incident, should the end-user fail to supply a valid CoC, insurance companies could dismiss a claim and or will not accept liability for costs of damage caused to property or assets.

The loss and damage suffered by an owner/user due to an unsafe Gas installation for which a valid CoC has not been issued, falls entirely on the owner.

Only Registered Gas Practitioners may issue a CoC.
