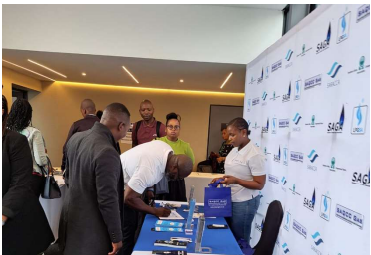
### Manufacturing Indaba 2023
